6 Things to Remember About "The Way of Cain"

- 1. "The Way of Cain" refers to any individual who attempts to approach God on HIS or HER own terms.
- 2. "The Way of Cain" describes any religious system that attempts to earn God's favor by <u>WORKS</u> and <u>RITUALS</u> rather than by reliance on God's grace.
- 3. "The Way of Cain" is any religious system that appeals to our PRIDE rather than our desperate condition before God.
- 4. "The Way of Cain" emphasizes humanity's <u>GOODNESS</u> rather than humanity's sinfulness
- 5. "The Way of Cain" says there are many <u>PATHS</u> that lead to God rather than one path
- 6. "The Way of Cain" leads to <u>ETERNAL</u> death rather than <u>ETERNAL</u> life.
