7 Questions to Consider

- 1. How did He arrange to be born in a specific family? (2 Sam 12:12-13)
- 2. How did He arrange to be born in a specific city, in which His parents did not live? (Micah 5:2)
- 3. How did He arrange his own death, and specifically by crucifixion with 2 others? (Isaiah 53:12)
- 4. How did He arrange to have His executioners gamble for His clothing? (Psalm 22:18)
- 5. How did He arrange to be betrayed in advance and to be crucified on the exact day that the Jews sacrificed a spotless lamb for their sins? (Zechariah 11:12-13, John 18:39)
- 6. How did He arrange to have the executioners carry out the regular practice of breaking the legs of the two victims on each side of Him, but not His own? And that was prophesied 1000 years before. (Psalm 34:20, John 19:32-33)
- 7. How did He arrange to come back to life on the exact day that He said He would? (Matthew 16:21)
