Last Sunday morning we looked at 3 examples from the New Testament who believed in the exclusivity of Jesus Christ for salvation. Those being:

Jesus Himself, Peter, and Paul

Acts 4:12

Another New Testament writer who believed there was no other way to salvation except through Christ Jesus was the Apostle Paul

Philippians 3:5-6, Acts 9:3-5, Romans 1:16-17, 2 Corinthians 11:24-25, 27, Isaiah 53:6, Romans 1:17, Romans 3:21-26, Ephesians 2:8-9, Romans 4:5

One other example from the New Testament that speaks of the exclusivity of Christ other than: JESUS, PETER, JOHN, PAUL, and the writer of the book of HEBREWS
