Another New Testament writer who believed there was no other way to salvation except through Christ Jesus was the Apostle <u>Paul</u>

Philippians 3:5-6, Acts 9:3-5, Romans 1:16-17, 2 Corinthians 11:24-25, 27, Isaiah 53:6, Romans 1:17, Romans 3:21-26, Ephesians 2:8-9, Romans 4:5

One other example from the New Testament that speaks of the exclusivity of Christ other than: <u>JESUS</u>, <u>PETER</u>, <u>JOHN</u>, <u>PAUL</u>, and the writer of the book of <u>HEBREWS</u>

- II. Christianity offers a superior <u>SACRIFICE</u>
